Guided Reading: Strategies, Activities, and Resources ...

Warm-up/fluency items (letter sounds or sight words, rereading familiar texts or parts of a text for fluency. Text introduction (discussing content, pre-teaching vocabulary, teaching a reading strategy) Reading the text (students read independently while you listen in to one student at a time) Post-reading conversation (addressing comprehension, re-visiting the teaching point or strategy from the text introduction, discussing how students could apply this learning to their independent reading)

How to Spice Up Your Guided Reading Routine - Learning at ...

This is guided reading, after all. In advance, prepare a teaching point, discussion questions, and (if desired) an extension such as word work or guided writing. Before the students begin reading, introduce the text.

Before, during & after guided reading activities - The ...

Every student completes the central activity and then chooses two other activities to make a line like in noughts and crosses. All the activities are based on the guided reading text that the students are reading. The files are presented as either a word document (one grid per page) or as publisher file (two grids per page).

Guided reading takes place in the classroom in a small-group setting where the teacher supports each child's reading development of new texts and different levels of difficulty. Each child in the group will individually read a passage of the text out loud that the teacher has chosen. Throughout the guided reading session, teachers will provide support and guidance to each child and set objectives and goals for the next session.

Guided Reading - Just how I do it...
